Bumi Armada Forest Tree Planting 2025

Bumi Armada Berhad collaborated with the Selangor Forestry Department in organising the Forest Tree Planting 2025 programme on April 29, 2025. This initiative is part of our ongoing commitment to environmental sustainability and in conjunction with the recent International Day of Forests, which was celebrated under the theme "*Forests and Innovation*".

The programme involved the planting of 200 forest tree saplings, specifically Keranji (Dialium indum) and Nyatoh Nangka Merah (Palaquium gutta), which have been classified as Endangered, Rare and Threatened (ERT) species. These natural forest trees have experienced significant population reductions as the result of illegal logging, habitat degradation and increasing impacts of climate change. The planting effort was completed in under an hour with the help of 40 Bumi Armada employee volunteers.

This initiative demonstrates our ongoing commitment to biodiversity conservation and natural ecosystem restoration, which is consistent with our sustainability goals and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, especially SDGs 13 (Climate Action) and 15 (Life on Land).
