

Seeds of Tomorrow 2.0 Mangrove Tree Planting

In celebration of International Mangrove Day, Bumi Armada Berhad (BAB), in collaboration with the Global Environment Centre (GEC) and Pertubuhan Sahabat Hutan Bakau Kampung Dato' Hormat (SHBKDH), organised the Seeds of Tomorrow 2.0 Mangrove Tree Planting Programme on 30th July 2026 at Tebuk Mendeleng, Sabak Bernam, Selangor, involving 22 employee volunteers. Building on BAB's mangrove restoration efforts since 2024, the project achieved a 90% tree survival rate following two years of maintenance and monitoring.

This year, BAB returned for a final maintenance visit and gap planting activity, planted an additional 250 mangrove trees (*Rhizophora apiculata* - Bakau minyak) to address remaining gaps, further reinforcing their long-term partnership with GEC and SHBKDH in restoring and safeguarding Malaysia's vital coastal ecosystems. The programme contributes to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 13: Climate Action, SDG 14: Life Below Water, SDG 15: Life on Land, SDG 1: No Poverty, and SDG 2: Zero Hunger, reflecting BAB's commitment to creating lasting environmental and socio-economic value through collaborative conservation initiatives.
