

Bumi Armada and Department of Fisheries Malaysia Strengthen Marine Conservation Collaboration Through MoU Exchange at MAHA 2026

On 2 September 2026, Bumi Armada Berhad (“Bumi Armada”) and the Department of Fisheries Malaysia (“DOF”) marked an important milestone in their collaboration through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) exchange ceremony held at the Malaysia Agriculture, Horticulture and Agrotourism Exhibition (“MAHA”) 2026 at MAEPS Serdang.

The MoU was exchanged by Ms. Sarimah Talib, Vice President of Sustainability & External Relations, Bumi Armada Berhad, and Dato’ Haji Adnan bin Hussain, Director-General of Fisheries, Department of Fisheries Malaysia. The ceremony was witnessed by YBhg. Dato’ Sri Norazman bin Ayob, Deputy Secretary-General (Policy) of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security (KPKM).

The strategic collaboration marks a significant milestone as Bumi Armada becomes the first contributor to the Marine Park and Marine Reserve Trust Fund (KWATLRL) to formalise a partnership with the Department of Fisheries Malaysia through an MoU.

The MoU reflects a shared commitment to advancing marine conservation and biodiversity protection, while supporting the implementation of conservation programmes and the effective management of Marine Protected Areas (MPAs). Through the collaboration, Bumi Armada and DOF will work together to support initiatives that contribute to the long-term protection of marine ecosystems and Malaysia’s valuable marine resources.

The partnership also highlights the important role of corporate contributions in supporting national conservation efforts. Beyond the partnership itself, the MoU is expected to serve as a catalyst for more corporate entities to contribute towards marine conservation through KWATLRL. It demonstrates how collaboration between the private sector and government agencies can foster a more coordinated and impactful approach to protecting Malaysia’s marine ecosystems and biodiversity heritage.

The MoU exchange at MAHA 2026 represents another meaningful step in Bumi Armada’s sustainability journey, reinforcing its commitment to responsible business practices, strategic stakeholder partnerships and positive environmental impact. Through continued collaboration, Bumi Armada remains committed to supporting national efforts to protect Malaysia’s marine environment and contributing towards a more sustainable future for generations to come.
